The large majority of them did not know Jesus, but they definitely heard about Him many times throughout the week! During the days, we got to take them on adventures that challenged them physically, mentally, and spiritually! We rock climbed and discussed the role of trust in life, in relationships, and with God. Then we rappelled from over a 180 foot cliff and discussed the beauty of creation and how it reflects the attributes of God. We also did a couple of hikes. For one of them we discussed how Jesus came full of grace and truth and for our last hike we went to see dinosaur footprints! It was incredible to think of dinosaurs romping around that area! It led to a discussion on legacy and how they would like to be remembered. It was so fitting to share a story from the Bible about the life of Rahab (a prostitute) and how God intervened in her life and completely changed her legacy! It was so cool to be able to clearly share the gospel of Jesus in so many different ways throughout the week. We ended our days with the Bridges Staff (International student ministry of Cru) leading Bible times on God as the Creator, God as the Father, and Jesus as God. The discussion groups that followed were so awesome to be a part of as we got to see God working right before our eyes helping students to see Him more clearly! Three of the students in my group did not know the Lord. For one student the concept of God was totally new to her! The other two ladies said that they wanted to know more about God, but they still had many questions about Him. The discussions continued late into the nights and we pray that the Lord would continue to reveal Himself to all of the students in powerful and intimate ways . . .and oh how we pray that they too will praise the Lord and proclaim His Name among their nations!
