4. Leadership Development

We now have 8 men and women who have started the weekly RPL classes conducted by Grace Baptist Amanzimtoti.

This numbers include pastor's wives who have no theological training attending in support of their husband's ministry in terms of counselling and other services.

We had our 2nd annual End-of - Year conference which was extremely successful. As a testament to the work God has been doing through each of these ministries the conference was attended by people from

across KZN, Mpumalanga, Gauteng and the Free State which are about 8 – 9hours drive respectively. This is one of the 4 conferences we host annually, it has been mind-blowing to see how the Lord worked in people's lives this year.



5. Youth Ministry

The Lord has been working in the lives of our young people. We have been seeing and increase in youth attendance and participation on Friday nights.

We were blessed to have been able to send 16 young people to youth camp this past year. We were also able to send 5 staff to camp as well. Violet served in the kitchen, both Neo and Mpume also served as counsellors and on the worship team. To God be the glory.
